I'll mask off the white acrylic area, and prime the brick. (That way I preserve the glue surface when gluing on the cornice.) Then I'll assemble the cornices and fit them onto the fronts. I also need to add the sills. Then I have to figure out how I'll install the layer inside the boxes that provides the windows, etc. Not much room to work there...
